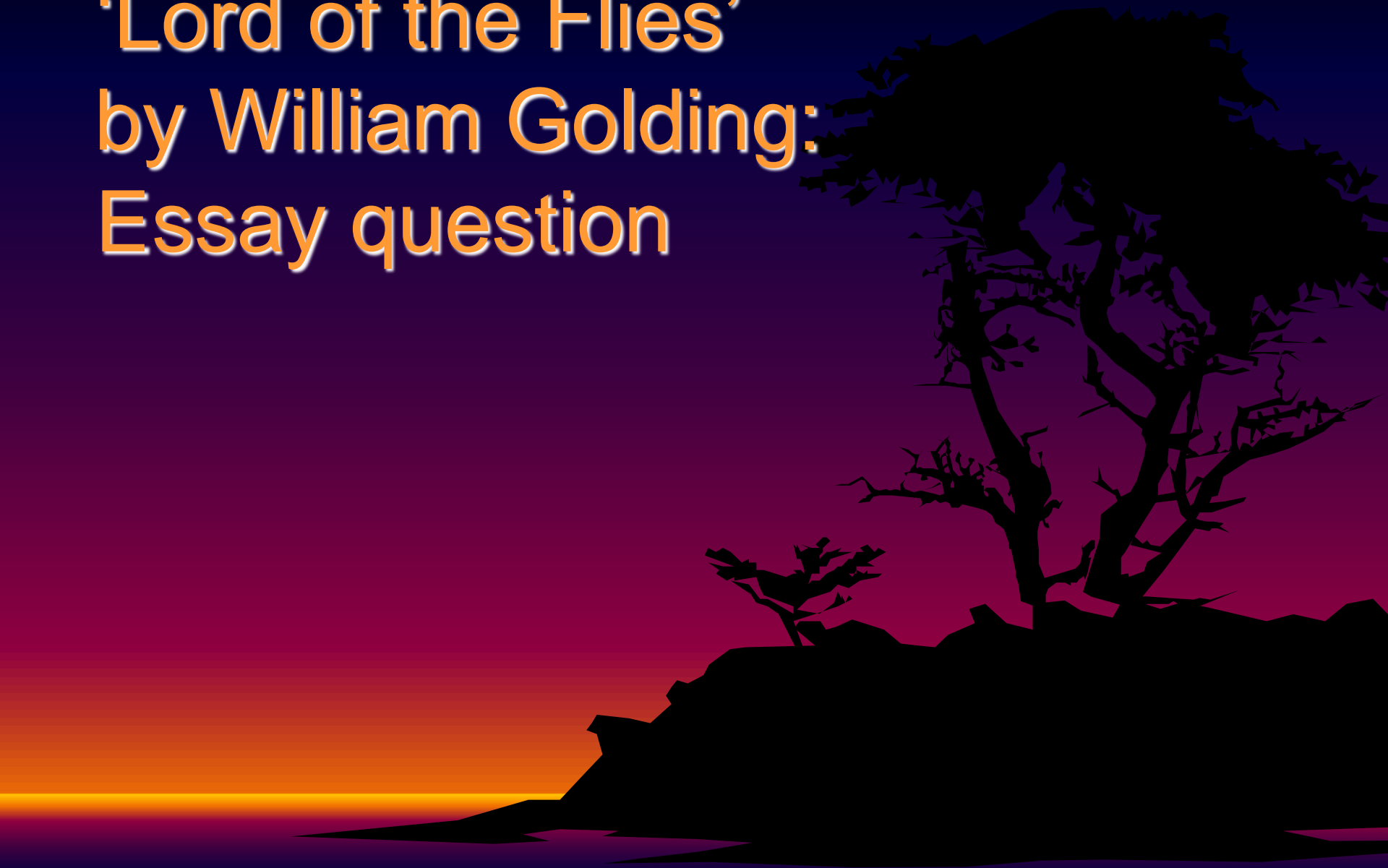


‘Lord of the Flies’ by William Golding: Essay question




Plan your answer to this question:

Approaching the question

1. Break the question down (use the bullet points to help)
2. Plan what you will say in each paragraph.
3. Make sure that you use the PEE structure as much as possible to support your ideas and gain marks!

How do the boys establish themselves as a community on the island in the first 3 chapters of the novel and how does the reader feel about this community?

In your answer, consider:

- how they organise their community
- who organises their community
- how the boys react to their community

1. Introduction: What happens to the boys? Where were they going? Where do they end up? Who are the main characters?

2. Paragraph 2: How do they organise their community? What becomes a symbol of their community?

5. Conclusion: how does the reader feel about this community? Are any other events foreshadowed? Is the reader hopeful for the boys?

4. Paragraph 4: How do the boys react to this community? Who likes/dislikes it? Does anyone have opposite views about it?

3. Paragraph 3: Who organises the community? How do they do it?
